





WHAT IS NEW HOPE SCHOOL OF LEADERSHIP?

New Hope School of Leadership has formed a unique partnership with Northwest University that allows students who feel called to ministry to obtain a fully accredited college degree with the opportunity to get hands on ministry training through the local church.

WHO IS NEW HOPE SCHOOL OF LEADERSHIP FOR?

This program is for anyone who feels called to ministry regardless if that's full-time ministry in a church or those who lead in the business world.

WHAT TYPE OF DEGREES ARE AVAILABLE?

- Certificate in Ministry Leadership
- Associate of Arts
- Associate in Ministry Leadership
- Bachelor of Arts in Ministry Leadership
- Bachelor of Arts in Psychology
- Bachelor of Arts in Business Management
- Bachelor of Arts in Organization Management

HOW DOES THE PROGRAM WORK?

We understand life is busy! With that, not all students who attend New Hope School of Leadership will be in the same season of life. We offer two unique enrollment plans:

1. Full-time student Program with internship at the local church

- This program offers a rigorous, full-time (30 credits per year), fully accredited online coursework.
- Offers two-year degrees in General Studies (AA) and Ministry Leadership (AML).
- Offers four-year bachelor's degrees in Ministry Leadership (BAML), Business Management (BABM) and Psychology (PSYC).
- Internship at New Hope for hands on training (12 hours per week). Internship is equivalent to one course per semester.

2. Flex Program

- This program is designed for adult learners desiring to increase their leadership capacity and continue their educational journey.
- Offers fully-accredited online college coursework as well as the same degrees listed above. The amount of time required to obtain degrees will vary based on the workload desired by the student.
- This program offers practical leadership development and mentoring throughout the course.

WHAT'S THE COST OF THE PROGRAM?

The cost for Northwest University is \$9,752 per year including the program fee. Students have access to federal financial aid and Northwest University services. Students under the age 25 also can request assistance (\$100 per class) from our Northern CA Nevada Assemblies of God district for the twelve classes that are required to get your ministry credentials!

WHAT ARE MY NEXT STEPS?

We realize that most students want to understand the out-of-pocket expense required prior to enrolling in classes. To figure out the exact cost for each individual student, it's imperative that they start the Application Process. Below are your next steps:

- 1. Complete and submit the New Hope School of Leadership Application. All applications should be submitted to our church office.
- 2. Complete the Northwest University Application at www.northwestu.edu/partnership/apply.
- 3. Order official HS or GED and all College transcripts. These should be mailed directly to:

4. Complete the FAFSA Application at www.fafsa.ed.gov.

You will need the following information to complete the FAFSA application:

- Your social security number
- Driver's license number
- W-2 forms
- Federal income tax return
- Current bank statements and records of stocks, bond & other investments.
- Records of other untaxed income received.
- Your business or farm records, if applicable.
- If you are NOT a US citizen, your alien registration number

*Dependent students: your parents will also need the same information and forms to complete their section of FAFSA. Your FAFSA cannot be processed without their information and signature.

After applying, students will be contacted with the financial aid amount awarded, out-of-pocket expenses and potential class schedule for the semester in which they desire to begin classes.
